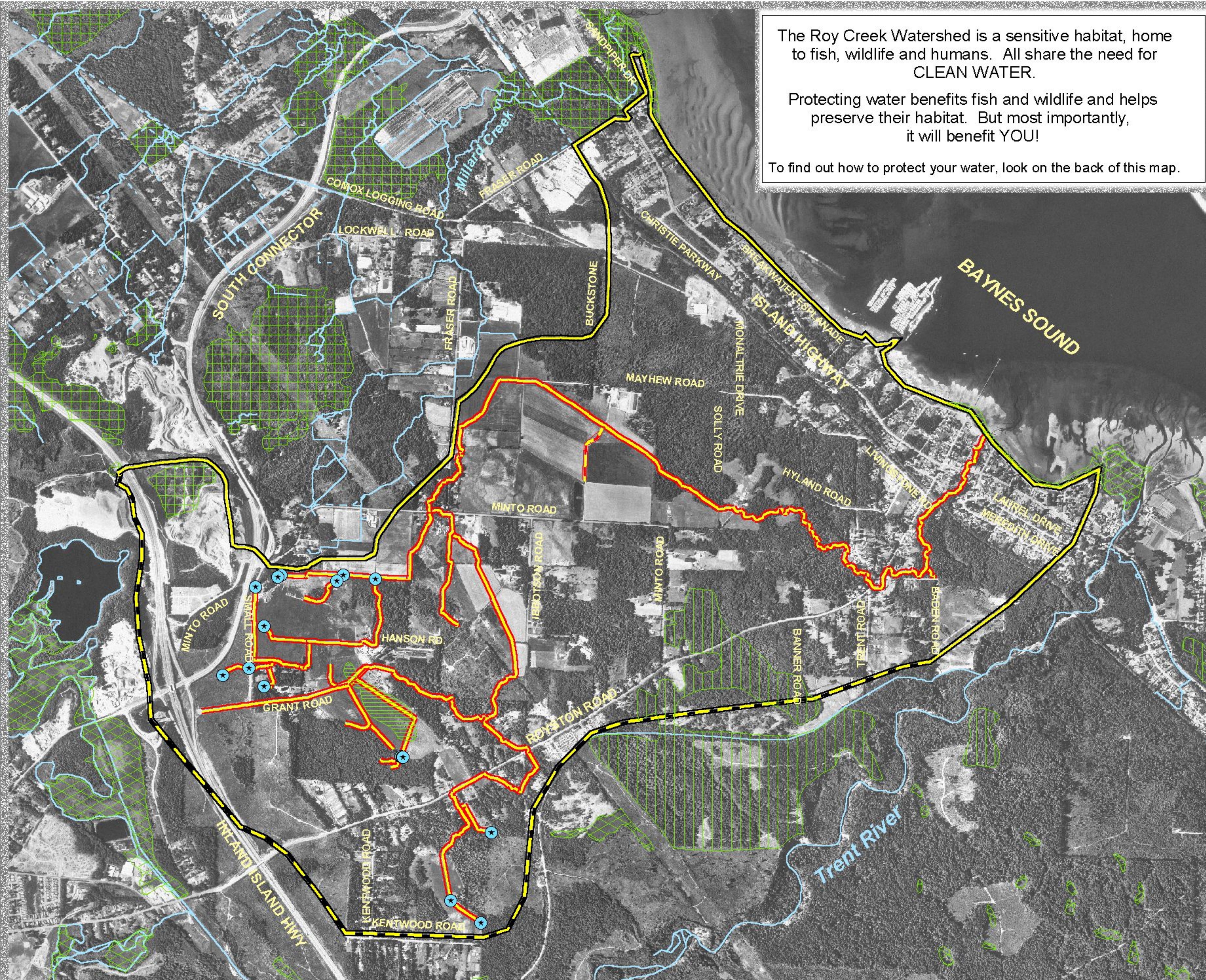




The Roy Creek Watershed is a sensitive habitat, home to fish, wildlife and humans. All share the need for CLEAN WATER.

To find out how to protect your water, look on the back of this map.

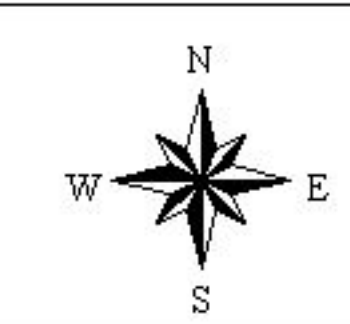
Roy Creek Watershed
